



2009 Pinot Noir, Holstein Vineyard

The 2009 Holstein is a co-fermented blend of Dijon 667 and 777 clones from the older blocks on the Vineyard. Situated in the heart of the Dundee Hills, this vineyard is planted on the Volcanic Soil the region is famous for. With classic red fruit and spice characters often associated with this cooler, clay based soil; the Holstein is a lush example. We selected our two favorite barrels from the lot which included one neutral barrel and one brand spanking new Billion Barrel adding up to 50% new French Oak.
