



2011 Deux Blancs

The 2011 Deux Blancs is a slightly different blend than last year, with 90% Pinot Blanc and 10% Auxerrois. In the 2011 vintage the Pinot Blanc was very high toned with bright acidity and tart citrus notes so we chose to blend in a touch of Auxerrois this vintage for more weight. The components were fermented in a mix of neutral French oak barrels and stainless steel barrels with 100% native yeast fermentations. The final wine is typical of the Deux Blancs of the past with fresh, vibrant acidity, bright citrus notes and a slight savory, herbal quality with floral aromatics. This wine is perfect for summer, as soon as it gets here!
