



### **2011 Pinot Noir, La Combe Verte, Willamette Valley, Oregon**

La Combe Verte means "The Green Fault" or "The Green Valley" and was named for the amazing team at Patricia Green Cellars. Without their help we would still be sorting grapes! Essentially, it is Patricia Green Cellar's "fault" that we were able to start this project.

This wine is a blend of vineyards from throughout the Willamette Valley with both younger vineyards to give the wine vivacity, but also established older vineyards giving the wine a deep complexity. In total the wine spends 10 months in French Oak barrels with 25% new oak. The wine is neither filtered nor fined prior to bottling.
