

2012 Pinot Noir, Clos Des Oiseaux, Eola-Amity Hills

The Clos des Oiseaux vineyard sits on the east ridge of the Eola-Amity hills overlooking the Cascade Mountains. The vineyard has a river of thin soil running through the middle with deep clay on either side, generating very diverse fruit from the site. The clones are co-fermented with native yeasts and then aged for 15 months in barrel, all French oak with 40% new oak in the final blend. The wine is not filtered or fined prior to bottling.
