



### **2013 Chardonnay, Vojtilla Vineyard, Chehalem Mountains**

The Vojtilla Chardonnay is a very textured wine, which can be attributed to these 23 year old vines. The wine has a subtle and refined nose consisting of white peach, flowers and grilled bread. On the palate the wine is dense with an almost oily viscosity on which flavors of peach and hazelnut glide to a long mineral finish.

With just 1 acre of Chardonnay planted on this Ladd Hill Site, the wine is extremely limited. The juice is fermented and was aged in both one new and one third use puncheon for 11 months with 100% native yeast fermentation and minimal bâtonnage. The wine was blended into tank and cold stabilized where it homogenized for 3 months. The wine was gently fined and filtered prior to bottling to polish the aromatics, 55 cases were bottled from this blend.
