



2013 Pinot Noir, La Combe Verte, Willamette Valley

While 2013 was a challenging year, it came down to the growers, their hard work and dedication. What sits in barrel is a testament to them. All of our Chardonnay and a good percentage of Pinot came in before the rain. The resulting wines are beautiful, elegant and high-toned. After the rains, the grapes spent some time drying off in the sun, and once picked, provide stunning fruit, with rich, lush notes reflecting the long warm summer that we enjoyed.

Almost entirely Eola-Amity Hills fruit, this vintage gave a much softer, sexier wine than either 2011 or 2012. It is quite floral, with purple flowers and subtle brown spices layered with ripe red fruit notes hinting at strawberry and raspberry. The palate follows with soft tannins and juicy acidity that lead to a succulence and gentleness of spicy red fruits that carry through a fairly lengthy finish. Overall the wine is fleshy and super easy to like.
