



2014 Pinot Blanc, Crannell Vineyard, Eola-Amity Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon

We have the incredible fortune of working with incredible site for Pinot Blanc, planted on a site that would be fit for top Pinot Noir. Pinot Blanc is not easy to find in Oregon, and when you do, finding premium sites is even harder.

Our 2014 Pinot Blanc is sourced from arguably the best Pinot Blanc vineyard in Oregon, Crannell Vineyard, which is well over 25 years old! Crannell sits on the east slope of the Eola-Amity Hills, in what we consider to be the “Golden Slope” of the Willamette Valley. The soils are comprised of volcanic clay with varying amounts of basalt rock content.

We harvest the fruit; press the juice off whole cluster. The juice is fermented in neutral oak barrels with ambient yeasts where it is allowed to go through 100% Malolactic fermentation. Finally, the wine ages for 6 months in barrel prior to bottling. The wine is unfined and unfiltered.
